3. Applicants must have been accepted by a degree-granting institution (either a two-year or four-year type).

**GENERAL RULES**

1. The amount to be awarded annually to recipients is \$500.
2. The amount is to be divided into semester or quarters and provided on this basis.
3. Renewals of \$500 annually can be received by the original recipient provided a "C" average has been maintained and grade transcripts are sent to the Committee from the educational institution attended.
4. Applications are evaluated and screened by the Scholarship Committee. Those applicants chosen for further consideration will be called to a meeting with the Committee for a personal interview. The Committee shall then make their final decision.
5. Letters will be sent to all applicants informing them of the final decision.
6. All above shall be considered on an "As funds are available" basis.
